## Feniton C of E Primary School Autumn Term 2018 Year 3

Our themes for this term are:

### Wonka's Healthy Snack Factory-

'How can we be the best we can be?' We will be using Charlie and the Chocolate Factory by Roald Dahl to inspire our work.

### Let's Celebrate!-

'What do people celebrate and how?' We will use art, poetry and play scripts to investigate the Nativity, Diwali and Bonfire Night.

**Maths** - Number skills, place value, fractions, data handling, times tables.

**English** - Story settings, poetry and play scripts. We will focus on correct punctuation, including the use of commas and paragraphs.

**Spelling** - Different graphemes for the long vowel sounds; prefixes + suffixes

**RE** - An introduction to Hinduism and investigating festivals including Diwali and Christmas. We will have a Diwali afternoon to find out more about this festival! We will also explore what we can learn from the Creation story.

**PSHE** - Improving listening skills, anti-bullying and learning how to work as part of a team.

**Science** - Animal nutrition and skeletons.

**Computing** - Internet safety, data handling and using design and editing skills to create PowerPoint presentations.

**PE and Games** - Tag rugby, dance and team building activities.

**DT** - Researching, designing, planning and making healthy snacks.

**Music** - 'Animal Magic', using sound to represent movements and Christmas show rehearsals.

**ART** - Creating and sketching celebration scenes.

**French** - Counting and basic conversation skills. We will also be learning some French songs!

**Geography** - Using OS maps to compare, contrast and create rural and urban areas.

\***Reading Record Books** - These should be brought in each day and should be used for writing book reviews and recording any reading. Please read daily (even if only for 5 minutes!)

\* **PE is on Tuesdays and Games is on Wednesdays.** Please ensure **NAMED** kit is in school on these days. For the first half term, PE and Games will be outdoors (weather permitting).

\* **Homework** will be checked on **Wednesdays and out again on Thursdays.** See homework books for details.
