

The term begins with 'My Mother Saw a Dancing Bear' which is a study of the poetry of Charles Causley. Through it, the children will learn to comment critically on the overall impact of a piece of poetry, showing how the poet has used language to create mood and effect. Further poems by the same author will be considered as the term progresses.

Within Scientific enquiry the children will be carrying out an environmental investigation, They will design, experiment record and conclude an investigation of their own choice.



Maths will begin with a consolidation of fractions, which will include reasoning problems to extend the children's understanding and allow them to become experimental in the way they calculate and explain their choices. The children will embark upon the topic of geometry and look at tackling 'financial education' during the second half of the term.

The Summer term always holds the excitement of Art Week. This year we will be studying a particular artist and trying to recreate his or her methods of expression. In year six, we will be looking at street art and in particular the works of the notorious Banksy. We will apply our knowledge of our chosen artist in Art week by freshening up the fiberglass farm animals currently at the front of the school.
